



The purpose of Junior Research Fellowships is to offer candidates of exceptional intellectual calibre, for whom the Fellowship would be their first substantial paid academic or research appointment, an opportunity to pursue research for up to four years.

When writing your reference, please note that candidates will be judged against the very highest academic criteria across different fields. In particular, the standard of research expected for election to a Research Fellowship is much higher than that which is adequate for a PhD. The Committee would therefore value your views on the applicant's research work; in particular, they hope you will be able to give them an assessment of its quality, to assist them in deciding whether they should be invited to submit a dissertation. Dissertations will be sent out to expert referees. On the basis of these referees' reports, the Electors will select as Research Fellows candidates who have shown the greatest intellectual achievement and promise. There are no interviews.
